FAU subscribes to dozens of research databases. Listed here are full text databases compatible with, and supportive of, the curriculum at Digital Media Arts College. These databases cannot be accessed from DMAC computers or your home computers. To access any FAU database, you must go to the campus and use a computer in their library reference area. This area is on the first floor to the right as you walk into the library. You do not need an FAU card to enter the library or use the computers. You can download or print articles.

Art / Image Databases

American History in Video | Vendor: Alexander Street Press

■ **Contents/Info:** *American History in Video* provides the largest and richest collection of video available online for the study of American history, with 2,000 hours and more than 5,000 titles on completion. The collection allows students and researchers to analyze historical events, and the presentation of historical events over time, through commercial and governmental newsreels, archival footage, public affairs footage, and important documentaries. This release includes over 1260 titles, equaling approximately 420 hours.

■ **Contents/Info:** ARTstor is a non-profit initiative, founded by The Andrew W. Mellon Foundation, with a mission to use digital technology to enhance scholarship, teaching and learning in the arts and associated fields. The ARTstor Digital Library Charter Collection is a repository of hundreds of thousands of digital images and related data and tools to actively use those images. [If you want to be able to make full use of ARTstor, you will need to register. You may register on campus or off campus via EZproxy.]

Design & Applied Arts Index (DAAI) | Index Only 1973-present | Vendor: CSA

■ **Contents/Info:** The Design and Applied Arts Index (DAAI) contains over 130,000 annotated references from more than 500 design and craft journals and newspapers published from 1973 onwards, and data on over 50,000 designers, craftspeople, studios, workshops, firms etc., making it the largest index of its kind in the world. Research articles are covered, along with topical news items, conference and seminar reports, and book, video and exhibition reviews. Each reference includes full bibliographic details and a brief abstract. DAAI also includes two supplementary databases: *Education Directory* and *Periodicals Directory*.

NYPL Digital Gallery | **Full Text** | Vendor: NYPL ■ Open Access

■ **Contents/Info:** NYPL Digital Gallery is the New York Public Library's new image database, developed to provide free and open online access to thousands of images from the original and rare holdings of the Research Libraries. Spanning a wide range of visual media, NYPL Digital Gallery offers digital images of drawings, illuminated manuscripts, maps, photographs, posters, prints, rare illustrated books, and more. Encompassing the subject strengths of the vast collections of the Research Libraries, these materials represent the applied sciences, fine and decorative arts, history, performing arts, and social sciences.
